Dear Parents,

I hope you all had an enjoyable summer and that your children are looking forward to their final year at St. Mary's. I am writing to inform you of the work we will be covering in class over the next two terms, class timetable arrangements and also to let you know the dates and times of some events that will take place this term.

For maths and literacy the children in years 5 and 6 will be taught in groups, according to attainment. Homework will be set by your child's maths and literacy teachers on a weekly basis. The children have been told which groups they are currently in but we will monitor progress carefully, and move children around throughout the year, to ensure they are always in a group where they are achieving their full potential.

In literacy we will be focussing on word classes, advanced punctuation and spelling patterns and rules as well as thinking about narrative writing, fiction genres, poetry based around global issues, newspaper reports, playscripts and recounts. In addition we will be looking at the text 'George's Secret Key to the Universe.'

Our maths topics will include distance, time place value, calculation, fractions, area and perimeter.

In R.E. we will begin by looking at the creation story and Jesus' baptism and introduction to his public ministry, in term 2 we will study miracles, the sacrament of the sick, advent and Christmas. Many of the children will also be confirmed this year, preparation for this will take place in class, making it a very special and exciting year for us all.

Our creative curriculum topic theme is entitled 'To Infinity and Beyond...' and incorporates literacy, maths, RE, history, geography, art, ICT, DT, PSHCE, French, music and science. A curriculum map accompanies this letter in order for you to see how everything fits together.

During science lessons this term the children will learn more about the earth and the solar system. We will be conducting hands on experiments to describe the movement of the earth relative to the sun. We will also look into why we experience day and night. We will also study electricity.

Games lessons for year 6 will take place on a Thursday and Friday afternoon. Please make sure your child has a P.E. kit in school on these days. Swimming will be on a Monday afternoon. Please let me know in writing if your child is unable to take part in a PE or swimming lesson.

In UKS2 the children will have some form of homework each evening. The homework will usually be set in accordance with the timetable below;
