Homework Expectations

Children will continue to be given homework weekly in Literacy and Maths. The homework will be set on Google classroom in order to minimise work being taken in and out of school. The children have homework books for both subjects, but these are to be kept at home. Tasks set should be done in the homework books where possible and a photograph uploaded to classroom. This ensures that screen time is kept to a minimum. Work will be set on a Thursday each week and we ask that both pieces are submitted before 6pm on a Sunday. In addition to this we ask that children read for at least 10 minutes every evening. Times tables and other maths facts can also be practised regularly.
